

Clothing List for Girls

For All Pupils

Regulation Uniform

- *1 regulation formal jacket
- *1 regulation school neck scarf
- *3 regulation grey skirts
- *8 regulation blouses
- 1 pair flat black leather shoes (not suede or trainers) worn with short ankle socks (white or natural colour)

Muslim girls may wear trousers instead of a skirt, if they wish. If they choose to wear a headscarf, it should be white.

*Items will not be available until after term starts

Basic Regulation Games Clothes

- 3 pairs black sports shorts
- 3 regulation sports polo shirts (to be bought from the School Shop at the start of term)
- 4 pairs white sports socks
- 1 pair indoor trainers (non-marking soles)
- 1 pair outdoor trainers
- 1 black or dark blue swimming costume (one-piece)
- 1 sports bag

Optional Sports

In addition to the above, your daughter will require other items of kit for various sports that she will opt for. Also, those selected for school teams may be asked to purchase certain items of team wear.

For Boarding Pupils

Additional Items

- 10 pairs short ankle socks (white or natural colour)
- 10 pairs underwear
- 4 bras (white or natural colour)
- 3 sets pyjamas/nightwear
- 1 pair indoor footwear/slippers
- 1 umbrella
- Brushes, comb, nail scissors, washbag/spongebag, 8 clothes hangers
- 2 laundry bags for underwear and socks
- 4 Large towels (not bath sheets)
- 1 plate, mug or cup, selection of personal cutlery/utensils. (Please note that nothing with a heating element will be allowed in pupils' bedrooms.)
- alarm clock
- desk lamp (optional)

Casual Wear

Casual wear may be worn after lessons and at weekends. Casual wear should not be immodest, calculated to shock or be scruffy or dirty. Because of storage space limitations, the amount of casual clothing brought to school should be limited.

Laundry Temperature

Pupils' clothing is not washed by hand. All pupils' clothing must be capable of being washed at temperatures between 40° and 60° centigrade. The School does not accept responsibility for damage caused to garments by the laundry process. Dry cleaning is available.

Naming

All clothes, including casual wear, must be named. Tapes must be of the sewn-on variety. A charge may be made for the labelling of any clothing brought back to school unnamed.
