



## A Level Choices 2016-2018

At the Prince of Wales Island International School, A Level students will normally study 3 or 4 subjects. A common choice is to study 4 subjects at AS Level (Year 12) and to continue with 3 of these to the full A Level (Year 13). A very few students may wish to study 5 subjects; for example, some students wishing to study Further Mathematics at A Level choose to study 5 A Level subjects in order to maintain breadth. However, this is considered highly unusual and will only be allowed in exceptional circumstances.

In order to plan the curriculum next year, we need to know the subjects you hope to take for A Level. **This is for planning purposes only and subject decisions can be changed at a later date.**

The table below details the subjects offered. DT has not yet been confirmed. You may choose any combination of subjects you wish:
